



Guided Discovery of the Boreal Forest (Winter 2019-2020)

In the company of a naturalist guide, discover the boreal forest ... In the heart of Fôret Montmorency's fir and white birch forest, discover natural features of this research and teaching forest, find trails and traces of animals (if soil conditions allow) in the environment and learn more about the flora and fauna. You might also have some charming encounters!

The most common animal indications are of: snowshoe hare, red squirrel, moose, Canada lynx, American marten, porcupine, red fox, beaver, spruce grouse and ruffed grouse. Occasionally signs are seen of: timber wolf, fisher, river otter.

Price: \$22.32 + taxes /person

Period: upon reservation and depending on the availability of our guides

Duration: 2 to 3 hours

Minimum age: any child who can easily travel on own for 4 kilometers

A minimum of 6 people is required to hold the activity (maximum 12 people per guide)

Reservation required / Morning or afternoon departures are possible

Bring:

- Clothing and boots appropriate for the season and the particular physical activity, ideally dark-colored clothing and quiet fabrics.
- A snack and water for the hike
- Camera (optional)

The guide may cancel the activity in case of a special situation or extreme weather. In these cases, the activity is transferable or refundable.
